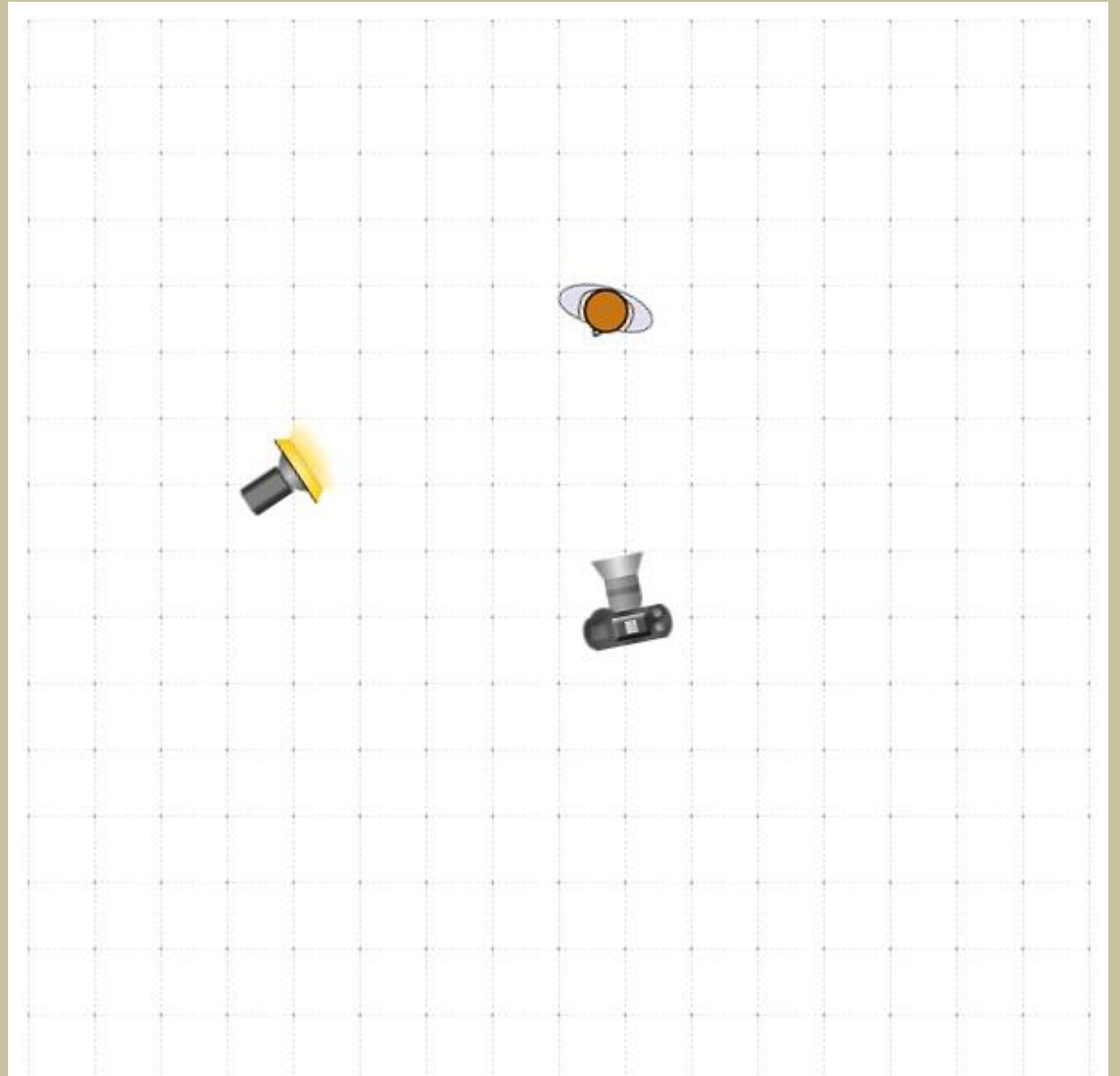


3 Point Lighting

- The Key light
- The Fill light
- The Back light

Key Light

- Main light
- Strongest Light
- Position to the left of the camera

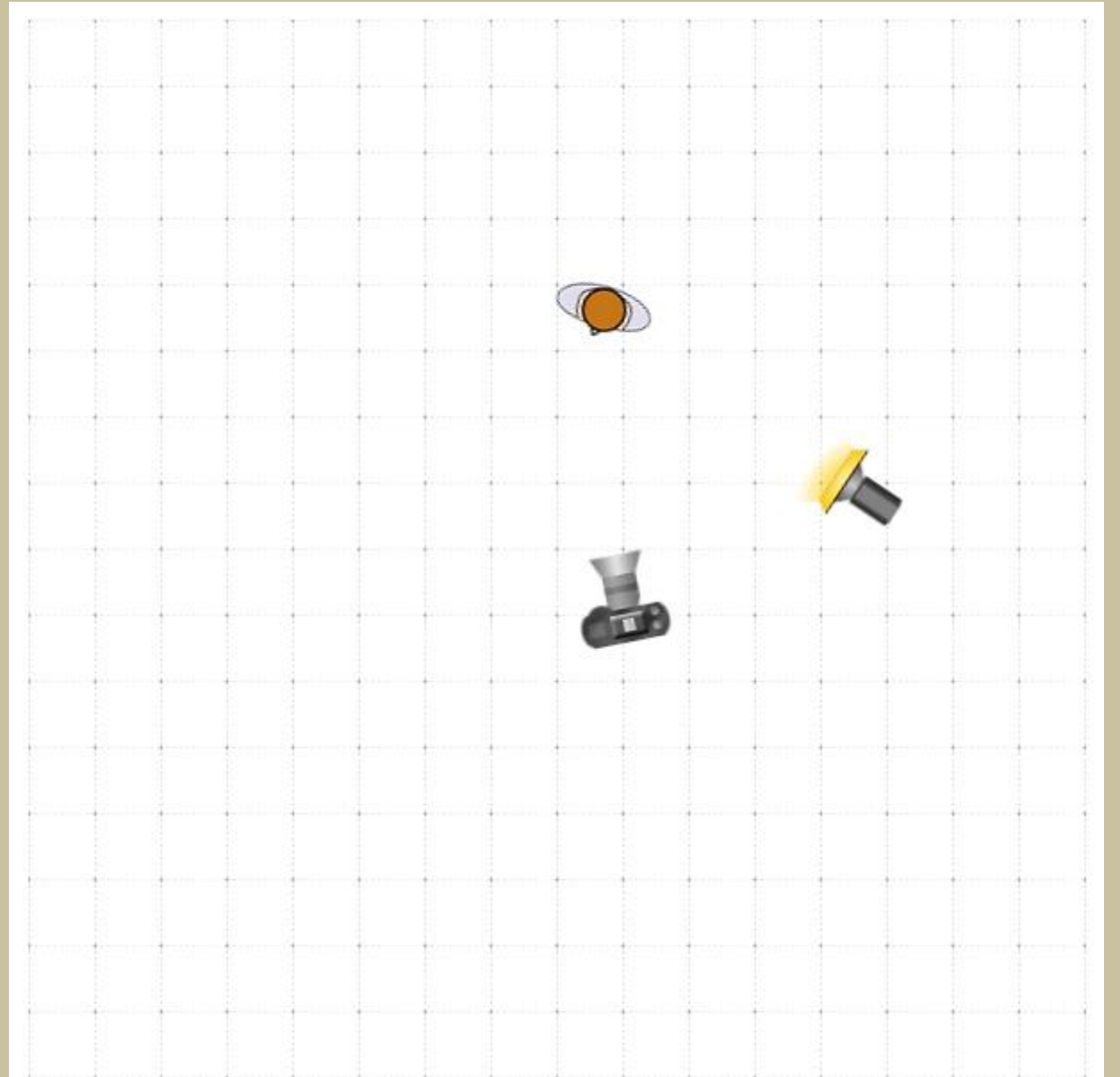


Key light

Key + Fill



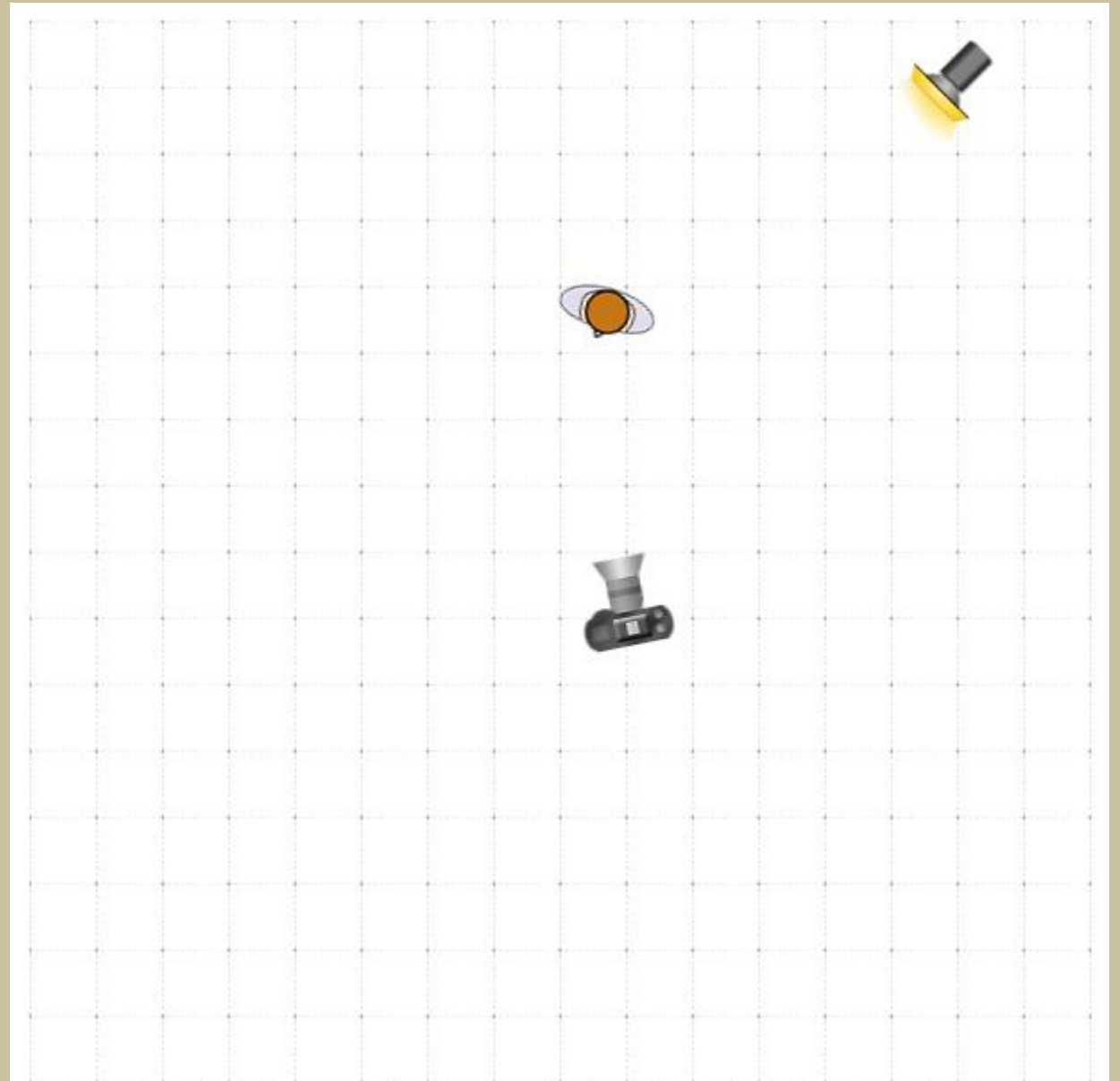

Back Light

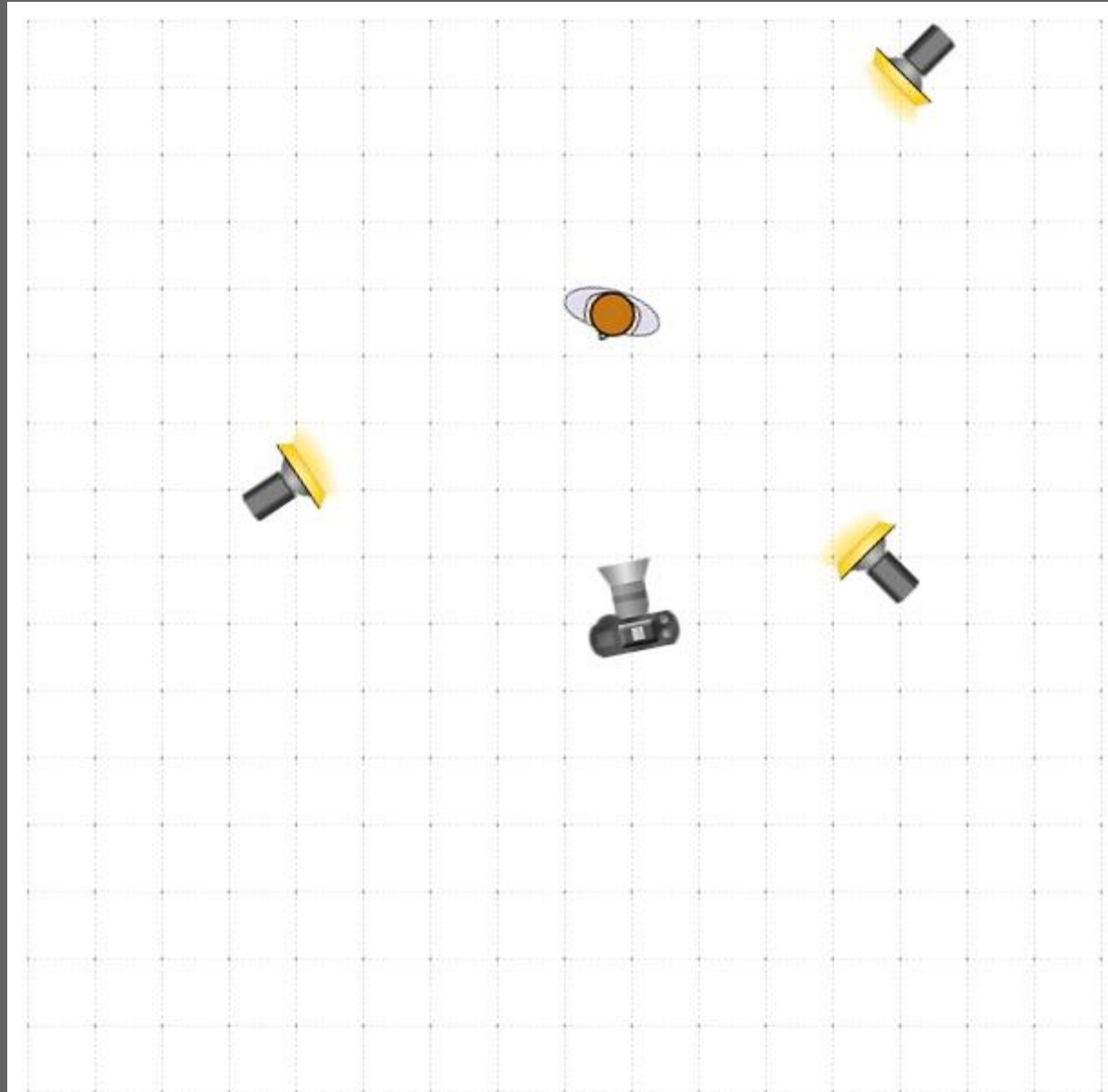
- Illuminates Hair & Shoulders
- Separate subject from the background



Back Light



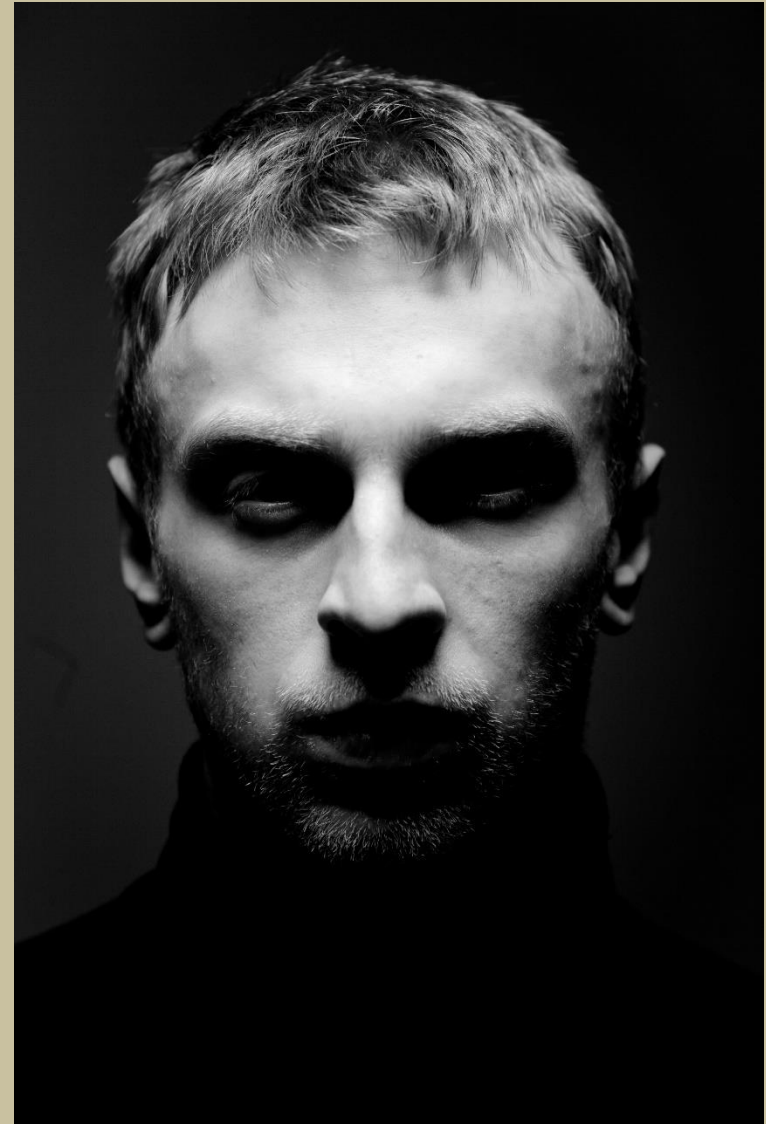
3 Point lighting

- **Emotion**

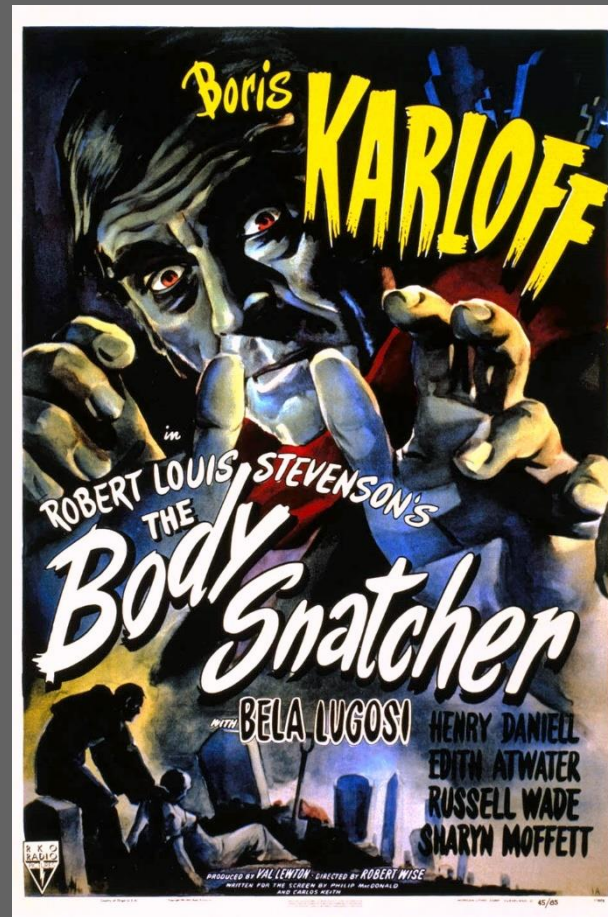

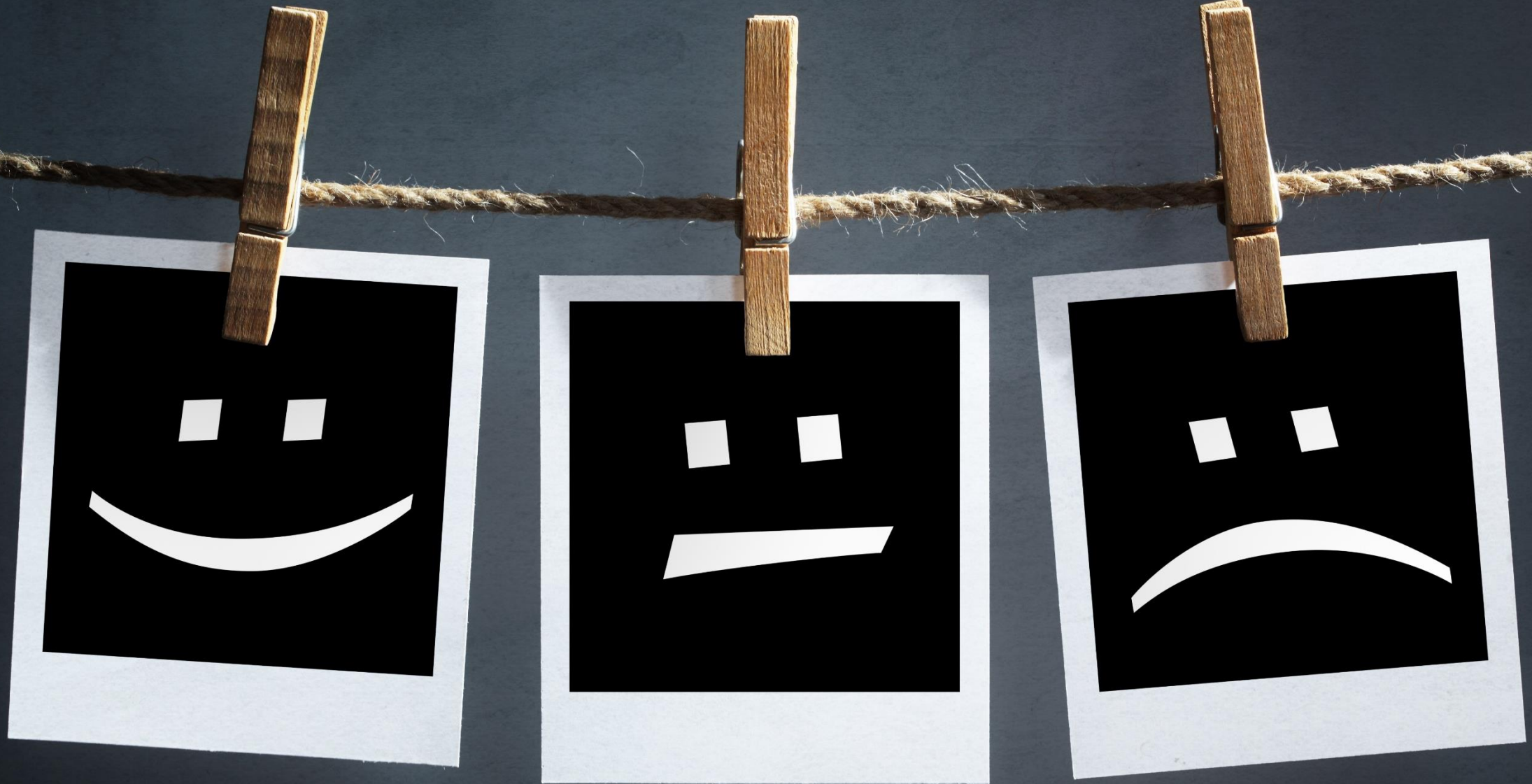
