



Web Designer

is responsible for the look and feel of a website

This includes colours, fonts, layout, menus, and navigation









Professional Development Roles Web Designer

 (responsive design, etc)
- Visual user experience

is responsible for functionality on the front-end of a website

Back-End Developer





Back-End Developer

is responsible for the logical processes and core computations of a web application

- Error-handling and recovery
- > Organisation and maintainability
- Building Content Management
 Systems

Strong Knowledge:

- Back-End Languages
 - Libraries
 - Frameworks
- Logic and Calculation
- Database APIs (SQL)










Professional Development Roles Back-End Developer

is a term used to describe a developer that is familiar with working on both the front- and backend of a web application




